1. Approved minutes from September 18, 2019.
2. *Set Future Coalition Meeting Dates: **Wednesday, November 13th next meeting.***
3. *Drug Take Back Day – Saturday, October 26 at Village Hall. Can also collect vape pens without batteries.*
4. *Hidden in Plain Sight/Student Data Presentation – October 24 in the HS Library. Judy Mezey from Student Assistance Services will present Hidden in Plain Sight with our set up.*
5. *MEGA Body/Red Ribbon week – MS Monday/Tuesday, HS Wednesday/Thursday during PE classes. Educator will throw ball to students to answer questions. Focus on effects of alcohol, marijuana, vaping on human body. ½ of group walks through the body, other ½ plays “Wheel of Misfortune” and then they switch. Final presentation/wrap up with educator at the end. Will have distortion goggles at the HS also.*
6. *Mets Fundraiser – Subway series is July 28 and 29th. Theresa, Tony & Rina are scheduled to be at a conference that week. Theresa needs a point person to commit to be at the game. Group voted to hold off on early commitment.*
7. *New Screenagers Movie – Group got together to review new movie and realized it wasn’t appropriate for our community.*

8. *Speaker* – Robert Hackenson – (www.dynamicinfluence.com) Vaping presentation, collaborate with Rivertowns Parents. Fee is \$2900 for 4 presentations (parents, MS, HSx2).
9. *High Achieving School Student Survey Presentation* – Students took the survey. Data due November 7th. Will be a video conference with vendor, Theresa and school to review data. Contract includes one presentation to the community, and one to the faculty. Survey focused on high achieving schools and the stress it causes.
10. *Projected Carryover Funds* – We have \$49k to carry over (didn't do placemats, digital board). Other items were discussed and approved. For example, some of the items discussed were: funds for e-cig/tobacco compliance checks, new 2nd form of ID tent cards to include tobacco age, mid-year training, sending two coalition members to NYS Juvenile conference in August.
11. *Holiday Label Themes* – Pizza boxes and liquor store bags. Asked Y2Y to come up with the theme for the labels.
12. *Fiscal Year 9 Activities have started. FY10 will end September 29, 2021.*
