- 1) Minutes approved from Thursday October 17th, 2019 Coalition Meeting.
- 2) Next Coalition Meeting is scheduled for 1/22/20 at 7:30pm.
- 3) The new Village social media policy is that anything posted to the Coalition's Facebook page or website must be approved through the Village Manager. No coalition member can post any content discussed at Coalition meetings or related to topics discussed at Coalition meetings to their personal social media pages as well.
- 4) During our last Drug Take Back Day on October 26th, 157 pounds of drugs were collected. And 104 pounds of drugs had been collected at the drop box located at the police station over the past 6 months.
- 5) Wellness Room Requests: new walls, new flooring, and furniture. All coalition members are in favor of allocating money to these requests (approximately \$10,000). Theresa will discuss with Meredith for final approval.
- 6) T-Shirt Request for Great American Smokeout: Approximately 50 T-shirts to made (approval still pending).
- 7) Coalition voted against having a Sadie Hawkins Dance, but will instead be planning a Faculty Talent Show to raise funds for AYA, SAYF Coalition, and Youth Police Program.
- 8) Holiday Labels are anti-vaping labels to be put on pizza boxes and anti-alcohol labels to be put on liquor bags.
- 9) Coalition voted against having Robert Hackenson as a speaker. Instead, looking into potentially having The Tall Cop as a speaker or Dr. Duey.
- 10) Projected carry over funds were reviewed, and coalition decided street banners and Youth to Youth funds can be allocated to other needed funds.
- 11) Coalition approved allocating Coalition's Trust and Agency funds to having two Middle School and two High School faculty members to attend the Holidays Aren't So Happy Conference.
- 12) Discussed and voted down participating in the Westchester County No-Vape November survey gathering campaign.
