2- Rina has started inputting the parent survey questions into Survey Monkey. Her research showed the tabulations, and the question format was better in Survey Monkey as opposed to Google Docs. Since we wrote the funding for Survey Monkey into this year's grant budget, we will proceed with Survey Monkey. We are aiming for the survey to go live mid-March.
